Workshop Objectives



Review Methods: Identify and review methods enabled by geospatial data sources to support better detection and characterization of environmental crimes and their consequences.



Enhance Awareness: Update on advancements in geospatial and open-source intelligence in the context of multidisciplinary evidence collection to assure environmental compliance.



Identify Gaps: Assess exploitation of EO capacity within enforcement authorities.



Define Requirements: Specify needs for EO and geospatial products in crime investigations



Align Strategies: Align with stakeholders' agendas to emphasize the need for evidence-based, data-driven crime-countering strategies that address the root causes and environmental, societal, and economic dimensions of crimes



Integrate EO Capabilities: Gather insights in priority areas to improve the integration of EO capabilities in intelligence workflows and protocols for environmental crime investigations.



Implementation Roadmap: Formulate a strategic roadmap with prioritized research areas and topics, for a wider uptake of EO into investigations of environmental crimes within the ESA-JRC cooperation activities.

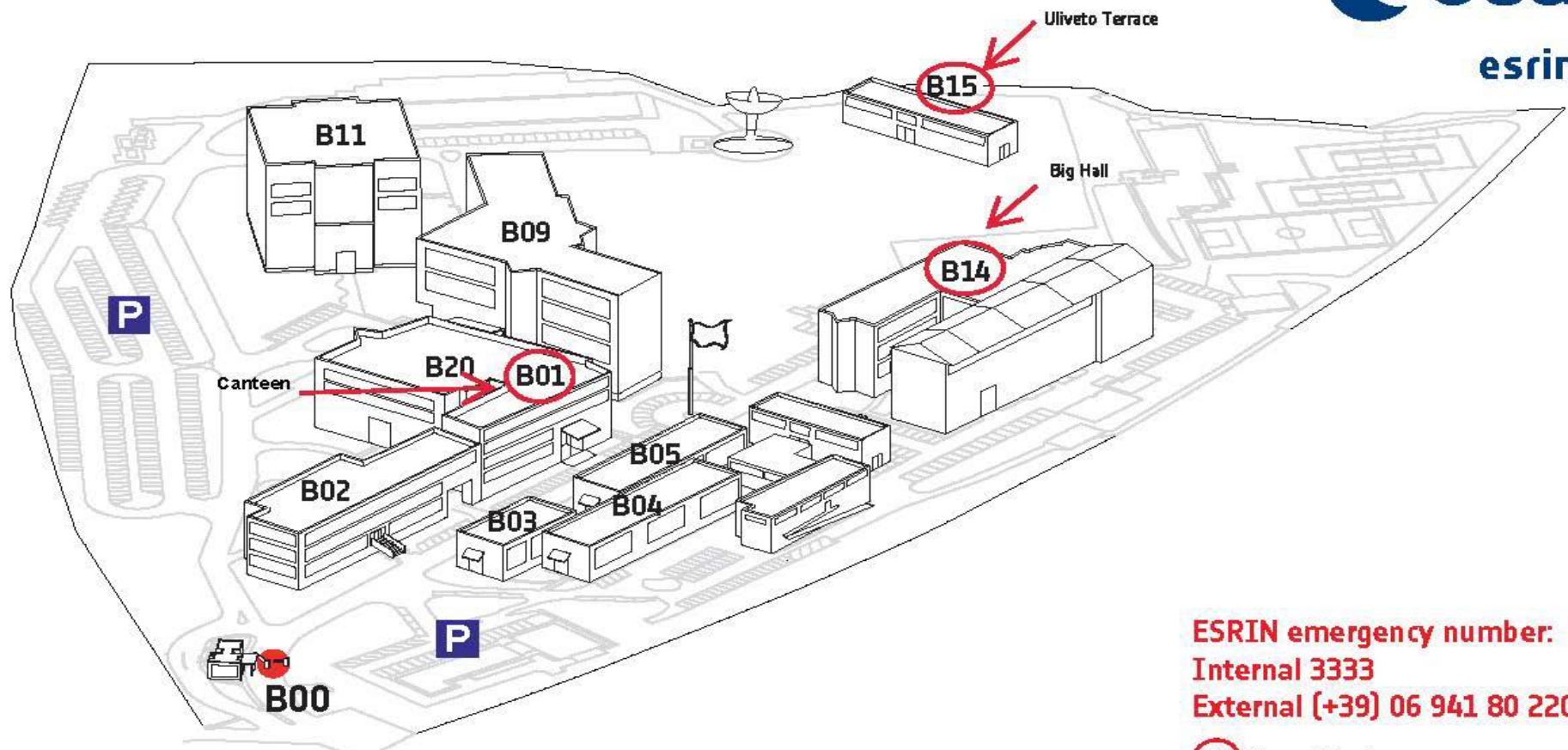
